This is important information on changes in your ATRIO Special Needs Plan (HMO D-SNP) coverage.

We previously let you know that your 2024 Evidence of Coverage (EOC) is available on our website or that you can call us to ask for a copy. Your EOC provides information about your coverage as an enrollee in our plan. This notice is to let you know there was an error in your EOC.
